The table sets out the numbers of County members by bow type and gender/age who participated in the League 2012. For those who like loose ends tied up the total by bow type does not match the total of individuals for two reasons;

1. Some participants shot barebow, a class for which any score counts towards recurve
2. Some participants shot different bow types in different months

I am grateful to the club contacts who have been tolerant of my queries of inconsistent odds and evens/hits and score and over handicaps, where I expect adjustments to be made for the following month when an archer exceeds their handicap level.

The range in the handicap totals (1221 in 30,000 points) shows that the system is effective. In contrast the range for the recurve was 3379 in 14,000 points, the longbow 1743 in 3866 points.

The participation by so many county archers indicates that the League is healthy and I would encourage more clubs and members to join in.

Finally thanks to the hosting clubs which make the League possible.
